A RESOLUTION memorializing the 45th anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision that legalized abortion.

WHEREAS, forty-five years ago the U.S. Supreme Court overturned all state laws on abortion, thus legalizing the destruction of innocent children in their mothers' wombs; and
 WHEREAS, since that tragic day more than sixty million have lost their lives by abortion; and
 WHEREAS, countless numbers of women have been victimized both physically and emotionally by abortion; and
 WHEREAS, men have had their roles as fathers and husbands adversely affected as well; and
 WHEREAS, adoption is available as a loving alternative to unplanned pregnancy; and
 WHEREAS, there are many qualified couples waiting to adopt, and adoption should be more accessible to qualified couples; and,
 WHEREAS, for many years members of the KY House of Representatives have sought to pass legislation that prevents the destruction of these innocent children and protects their mothers; and,
 WHEREAS, in 2017, the General Assembly was successful in passing legislation that further protected both the unborn and the women seeking these terrible procedures; and,
 WHEREAS, on January 22, 2018, the General Assembly hereby recognizes the establishment of the "Pro-Life Caucus" as a contingent of members who have committed themselves to defending innocent life and pursuing policies and legislation to right tis judicial wrong.

NOW THEREFORE,

Be it Resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

- *The House of Representatives reaffirms its commitment to respect for the dignity and sanctity of human life.*
- *The House of Representatives recognizes that children, whether born or unborn, are the greatest natural resource in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.*
- *This honorable body pledges to speak for, and uphold the rights of, members of our Commonwealth who cannot speak for themselves.*
- *This honorable body lauds the continued dedication of the Pro-Life Caucus to overturn the decision and to pass legislation to protect all vulnerable members of our society from conception until death.*
- *When the House of Representatives adjourns this day, it does so in remembrance of the countless number of Kentuckians who have been affected by the abominable U.S. Supreme Court decision of Roe v. Wade.*

ELECTIONS MATTER!

For over 40 years the Kentucky Right to Life PAC has remained a bi-partisan organization and this PAC Alert affirms we remain so today. Regrettably, however, the two relevant political parties are fundamentally at odds on the issue of protecting innocent human life in principle and in practice.

Republican Platform: "...we assert the inherent dignity and sanctity of all human life and affirm that the unborn child has a fundamental individual right to life which cannot be infringed. We support a human life amendment to the Constitution, and we endorse legislation to make clear that the Fourteenth Amendment's protections apply to unborn children."

Democratic Platform: "The Democratic Party strongly and unequivocally supports Roe v. Wade and a woman's right to choose a safe and legal abortion, regardless of ability to pay, and we oppose any and all efforts to weaken or undermine that right."
