Moore Elected Chair of the Pro-Life Caucus

FRANKFORT, Ky. (February 15, 2018) – On February 14, 2018, Rep. Tim Moore, R-Elizabethtown, was elected chair of the House Pro-Life Caucus, a group of representatives who have committed themselves to defending innocent life and pursuing policies and legislation against abortion.

The Pro-Life Caucus was officially recognized on Jan. 22, 2018, the forty-fifth anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* decision, which has led to the death of more than sixty million unborn children nationwide. The Caucus was not recognized in the past because until last year the House was controlled by a pro-abortion majority.

Moore said the caucus aims to protect the lives of future Kentuckians.

"The Pro-Life Caucus will work to pursue legislation and public policy to protect innocent, unborn life. Each of us individually is also committed to supporting the women and the families giving them the support and encouragement to choose life," Moore said. "We will not support this national disgrace."

Moore has been an outspoken of opponent of abortion since he joined the House in 2007. He has led the charge on numerous pro-life bills and resolutions, and delivered a powerful pro-life speech on the day the caucus was officially recognized.

Moore represents all of Grayson County and a portion of Hardin County.
