For Governor



MATT BEVIN

- **ENDORSED** by National Right to Life.
- **ENDORSED** by KY Right to Life PAC
- 100% pro-life responses to questionnaire
- During his first term, his administration successfully shuttered the Lexington abortion clinic, which had been masquerading as a doctor's office.
- "I am a husband and a father of nine. Being pro-life is not a political issue for me...I will not apologize for being 100% pro-life."

- Veteran—Officer in the U.S. Army; rose to the rank of Captain. He spent four years on active duty with primary responsibilities as the 5th Mechanized Infantry Division's Artillery counterfire officer.
- On 3/26/19, Governor Bevin signed HB148 into law. HB148 is a "trigger law", which will take effect immediately, should the U.S. Supreme Court nullify Roe v. Wade, making Kentucky pro-life once more.



ANDY BESHEAR

- **Endorsed** by NARAL (The National Abortion Rights Action League). NARAL sees Beshear as a reliable ally.
- "Yes, I'm pro-choice and I support Roe v. Wade...I think the parameters set forth in Roe v. Wade have the balance about right, and I would not support any changes to them. ***As governor, I would move to codify Roe v. Wade into state law if the Supreme Court overturned the decision.***"

- As Attorney General, Andy Beshear failed to defend pro-life legislation passed by the General Assembly. The quote above demonstrates that, as Kentucky's would-be governor, the state's chief executive officer, Andy Beshear has no intention of faithfully executing Kentucky's pro-life laws, such as Kentucky's trigger law, which was passed by the General Assembly in 2019.
- **Two abortion doctors** from Louisville's EMW clinic **hosted/sponsored a fundraiser** for Andy Beshear in July of this year. Minimum contribution was \$500.

ELECTIONS MATTER!

Before you vote, it is important to consider the pro-life integrity of individual political candidates. For over 40 years the Kentucky Right to Life PAC has remained a bi-partisan organization and this PAC Alert affirms we remain so today. It is a regrettable fact, however, that the two relevant political parties are fundamentally at odds on the issue of protecting innocent human life in principle and in practice.

Republican Platform: "...we assert the inherent dignity and sanctity of all human life and affirm that the unborn child has a fundamental individual right to life which cannot be infringed. We support a human life amendment to the Constitution, and we endorse legislation to make clear that the Fourteenth Amendment's protections apply to unborn children."

Democratic Platform: "The Democratic Party strongly and unequivocally supports Roe v. Wade and a woman's right to choose a safe and legal abortion, regardless of ability to pay, and we oppose any and all efforts to weaken or undermine that right."
