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This \$1000 scholarship is offered annually by Right to Life Educational Foundation of Kentucky to assist students who are committed to the pro-life ideals and philosophy.

All students from around the Commonwealth are eligible. The application forms may be found online at krla.org/scholarships.

In 2023, Kentucky Right to Life in partnership with our community Right to Life Chapters will award up to ten (10) \$1000 scholarships to Kentucky seniors.

The following criteria will be considered by a Scholarship Committee Judges:

1. Applicant must be a senior graduating from high school (home schooled students are eligible) in the current school year; have applied to a two- or four-year institution; been accepted; and will enroll for the Summer or Fall 2023 attendance.
2. Applicant must hold a genuine attitude respecting the dignity of life from conception to natural death and demonstrated pro-life activity and his/her high school years as well as a commitment to a continued involvement in pro-life activities in as they enter college i.e. Students for Life
3. Applicant must be a resident of Kentucky.
4. Applicant may be participate but not required to be, a member of a high school Teens for Life club.
5. Applicant **must provide two Recommendation Letters completed by adults (non-relatives)** who are familiar with their pro-life involvement and attitudes. These forms should be completed by a pastor, Teens for Life sponsor, teacher, guidance counselor, or other adult familiar with the applicant's pro-life activities and convictions.

APPLICATION PROCESS

A completed application is due on Monday, April 10, 2023 and consists of the following:

1. A completed application form signed by the applicant.
2. **An ESSAY/STATEMENT** (not to exceed 2 to 3 typed double-spaced pages) from the applicant describing how specific pro-life activities during high school have impacted the applicant's beliefs and philosophy and how it relates to his/her personal life journey.

- Applicant should give a description of his/her commitment to continue to support the ProLife issues and activities throughout college.

- Applicant should articulate their personal and consistent ProLife philosophy "on conception to natural death"

3. **ACTIVITIES FORM.** A complete list of activities, experiences, and volunteering during high school, particularly the extent of participation and involvement in pro-life and Teens for Life activities, including dates, hours per week, leadership, and awards.

4. **TWO RECOMMENDATION FORMS** (completed by two adults as explained in #5 above). Return these forms with the application in sealed envelopes signed across the seal or ask each adult to mail (or email prolifestudents@krla.org) it directly to the RTL Educational Foundation office postmarked by the **Monday, April 10, 2023 deadline.**



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EVALUATION CRITERIA

1. The applicant will be judged on not only on his/her educational achievements and aspirations, but their ability to express their views on dignity of all life and their committee to, the protection of all human life. Applicant's pro-life activities may be in the area of volunteering, organizing, fundraising, education, prayer, or service (to the elderly, the disabled, or pregnant women), a combination of any or all, or any other involvement that promotes the mission and goals of Right to Life Educational Foundation of Kentucky.

The mission of Right to Life Educational Foundation of Kentucky is to promote respect for the worth and dignity of all human life, including the lives of the unborn from the moment of conception, and the disabled and the elderly, until their natural death. (Abortion, Infanticide, Assisted Suicide, Euthanasia...)

2. The selection committee will consider the applicant's participation and involvement in pro-life activities, the attitudes, abilities, and the leadership qualities he/she demonstrates that show a respect for all life and a sincere commitment to continue his/her involvement throughout his/her continued education.

Additional information may be requested from the applicant.

The \$1000 scholarships will be awarded in May 2023. Every effort will be made to present the award in person at your school's senior Award Night. Scholarship recipients shall provide prior to award the name of the institution that he/she will be attending if not indicated at the time of the application.
